Cooper Elementary School's program goals were to replace an undersized and outdated gymnasium, add additional classrooms and an art room.

Abacus responded to this program need by master planning for future growth, using the existing topography to maximize usable square footage, and renovating existing space.

Using the site's existing topography, our design team created a lower level to the gymnasium addition that caters to the mechanical, storage, and outdoor toilet needs. We also renovated the existing gymnasium to become the new art room for the school.

The project fulfilled the district's program needs, yet didn't take away usable land needed for playground and recreation activity.
