James Madison Elementary School's program goals were to replace an undersized, outdated gymnasium, add classroom space and create a facility that could be used extensively by the community.

Our design team created the master plan for future additions to James Madison Elementary School; therefore, the answer to the client's program was already laid out.

The 9,500-sq.-ft. gymnasium addition has created a highly functional program space for the school, and has helped ease the space crunch that the district's recreation department has for youth programs.

The existing gymnasium was converted into two classrooms, which eases the need for a building addition.
